I don't want to be braggadocious, but you have the exact, I know exactly what's happened. If you want to see what congressional Democrats wish to do to America, just look at the result of yesterday's election in New York where their party installed a communist as the mayor of the largest city in the nation. Remember I've said we will never have a socialist elected to any post in our country. I used to say that and I was right. We skipped socialist and we put in a communist instead. That didn't work out too well.
